

Recycling for the Residents of American Township

The North Central Ohio Solid Waste District, in cooperation with the American Township Trustees and the Lima Mall, will be offering recycling on the first Thursday of each month from 2:30 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. at the northwest corner of the Lima Mall parking lot. Enter at the light on SR 309, next to the Golden Corral.

The following information is your guide for recycling at this location.



DO NOT MIX THE WOOD FIBER STREAM AND THE CO-MINGLED STREAM MATERIALS TOGETHER! PLEASE KEEP THEM SEPARATE!!!

THE WOOD FIBER (PAPER) STREAM



CARDBOARD: Corrugated sheets and boxes (flattened), cereal and other pasteboard packaging, file folders, poster board, paper bags, etc. Please cut down large boxes and remove plastic windows.

GLOSSY PAPER: Material that has a glossy sheen, including: magazines, catalogs, flyers, etc.

MIXED OFFICE PAPER: Office and school paper, including: copy, construction, envelopes, computer, tablets and pads, phone books, workbooks with **wire or plastic binding removed**, shredded office paper in plastic bags, and junk mail.

NEWSPAPER: Newspaper and all included paper items. **Plastic bags and rubber bands must be removed.**

BOOKS: Place hardcover and paperback books in a paper bag for easy separation.



THE CO-MINGLE STREAM



CANS: Aluminum or bi-metal cans, including empty aerosol cans. Containers must be rinsed free of food waste or other contaminants. Labels do not need to be moved. Small miscellaneous metal scrap items are also accepted.

PLASTICS: All plastic containers numbers 1 through 7 (no Styrofoam), shopping bags (multiple bags must be placed inside one bag and tied shut). Labels and lids do not need to be removed.



GLASS: Clean food and beverage containers. All containers must be rinsed free of food waste or other contaminants. Labels and lids do not need to be removed. **No bulbs, ornamental, plate/window, Pyrex or cookware glass.**

ALUMINUM FOIL: Aluminum foil and pans rinsed free of food waste and other contaminants.



IF YOU BRING YOUR RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS, THE RECYCLABLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE BAGS AND THE BAGS TAKEN BACK WITH YOU.

SORRY, WE CANNOT ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING: Adhesive materials (decals, tape); used tissue paper and paper towels; oil/food contaminated paper materials; film/photographs; paper containers with attached metal or plastic ends or spouts; cardboard juice or milk containers; propane (flammable gas) tanks; pet food bags; carbon paper; unidentifiable plastic; or items with food or other contaminants. Please keep your recycling clean.
