Please Help Us by Recycling Correctly

The recycling industry is going through difficult times and we need your help to keep this program sustainable now and into the future. Please make it a practice to follow the Do's and Don'ts listed below.

Thank you for recycling correctly!!!!

Do's

- Do only recycle #1 and #2 plastics only
- Do only recycle cardboard
- Do only recycle paper
- Do only recycle glass
- Do only recycle steel cans
- Do only recycle aluminum cans

Don'ts

- Don't put Styrofoam or plastic wrap in cardboard boxes for recycle
- Don't put commingle recyclables in cardboard boxes then place into commingle door
- Don't put cardboard in commingle door
- Don't put commingle in cardboard door
- Don't put any plastic container with the # 3-7 listed on the container
- Don't put any plastic toys in any door

Acceptable Recyclables



Paper

Ex. Newspapers, Mail, Advertisements, Office Paper, Magazines, & Phone Books



Cardboard & Paperboard

Paperboard Ex. boxes such as cereal, cake & rice boxes

- Flatten all cardboard & remove all plastic packaging and Styrofoam.
- Large cardboard boxes should be cut or folded smaller than 4 feet.
- No wet paper or boxes — No food residue



Glass Bottles & Jars Only

Food & Drink Glass Containers

- Remove all lids & rinse thoroughly,
- No food or liquids left in containers.



Plastic Bottles & Jugs

Ex. milk jugs, beverage bottles, shampoo bottles, laundry jugs & household cleaning bottles

#1 & #2 ONLY

- Remove all lids & rinse thoroughly,



Aluminum & Steel Food Cans

Aluminum food, beverage and pet food cans. Steel or bi-metal (tin) food, soup, coffee and pet food cans

Unacceptable Items:

Automotive product containers, chemical/pesticide containers, bowls, buckets, feed bags, flower pots, microwave/fast food trays, Styrofoam, toys, mirrors, ceramics, light bulbs, window glass, dishes, china, paint cans, aerosol cans, pots, pans, hangers, batteries or appliances.

No Plastic Bags or Plastics #3 through #7
